#### **Westminster UPDATE & General Reminders**

##### **REFUSE COLLECTION UPDATE:**

The bulk landscape debris collection for most of the community has been done. Carnaby, Granby, Colefax and Somerset will finish up this weekend, on Sunday. The larger piles left on the curbs of all streets will be collected on Sunday, due to scheduling. Please refrain from adding landscape debris to these areas.

##### **For bulk-item pickup please call Waste Pro Tel (239)422-5660, for items including:**

- (1) TV's, appliances, furniture, patio furniture
- (2) Other bulk household items

We appreciate everyone removing items from the curb, until such time bulk pickup resumes, as it is not only unsightly it attracts rodents.

##### **Post vegetation refuse collection:**

- (1) Please remove any landscape debris from the street, or have your lawn maintenance remove it, until such time municipal refuse collection resumes.
- (2) Vegetation debris (bagged or loose) can be dropped off "self-unloaded" temporarily at the Waste Pro - Mosquito Control 1840 Gunnery Road, Lehigh Acres. 7:30AM-6:30PM Daily.

##### **Lot cleanup/ARC Requirement**

- (1) Please resume weed remediation, which includes trimming, mowing and in plant beds and around existing trees.
- (2) Submit an ARC for any trees removed, with plans to replace.
- (3) For homes needing roof replacements, please note all tiles must be approved by ARC prior to installation. If your parcel is located within a neighborhood Association Governors Run 1, 2 or Fairloop or Somerset Villas ARC's must be approved by the neighborhood association prior to WCA.

#### **General Reminders**

- (1) Homes for rent must be rented to a "Single family" unit. Rent/room sharing is not allowed in Westminster regardless of the purpose.
- (2) Dogs must be always leashed when outdoors, not to be left unattended on porches or lanais. Clean up after your dogs
- (3) Please slow down when driving on our roads. Watch out for pedestrians in the crosswalk, in addition to golf carts.
- (4) Property inspections scheduled for October have been postponed to November due to the "State of Emergency".
- (5) Mulching of the common areas is in progress. It's currently being staged in the Community Center Parking Lot, which will be cleared following its application.
- (6) Patio items are to be stored within the confines of a lanai in all rear lots and can't be stored overnight outside of it.
