Check out your palm trees!

There have been several Queen Palms in the community showing evidence of Fusarium Wilt Disease recently. Please keep an eye on your Queen Palms and if you notice brown fronds that are hanging down and looking straggly and wilted, please contact your landscaper immediately to have him/her tell you if the tree is diseased. If it is, the tree has to be removed immediately. Be sure to have the tree stump ground also.

This disease is very contagious and spreads quickly. You do not need to wait for permission from ARC to have these diseased trees cut down. Please just let ARC know you have removed a diseased tree so we can keep track of where the trees are.

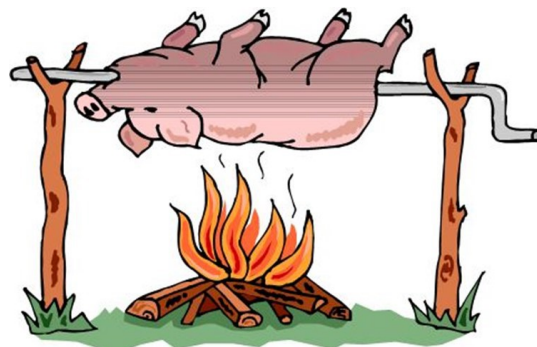

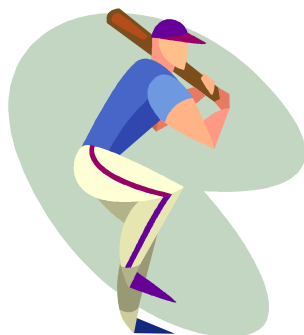
