Compliance News

Summer and the rainy season is ending and therefore it's time to spruce up our properties. There are three main things which need to be done.

1. Power wash roofs to get off the mold and mildew which has built up over the summer

2. Refresh the mulch in the plant beds for better effectiveness of irrigation and improved aesthetics

3. Clean the reddish brown stains from house paint.

See photo one depicting the rust stain on the house paint which probably was caused by the irrigation watering.

Residents have found it fairly easy to remove the stain (picture #1) with a product called "RustAid " (see photo #2).


Test it on a small area first following the product's directions. Picture #3 shows RustAid being sprayed on the stain and picture #4 shows the cleaning 30 seconds later by washing the discoloration off the house with cold water.
