ARC GUIDELINES CLARIFICATION:

ITEMS NOT REQUIRING ARC Notification and/or Approval

Item f) under Landscaping-

Landscaping that occurs within existing plant beds, which does not, according to the ARC constitute a major landscaping change, and whose plantings comply with Lawns and Landscaping Item K which states any tree or plant may be used in Landscaping except those on the list of unapproved Landscape/Plant materials in Addendum B which advises to consult the Leegov.com website - Landscaping Requirement - Invasive Exotic Plant Species List.
