# A note from Compliance Committee

The Compliance Committee has been dealing with several issues and would like to inform our residents of three items of recent concern.

1. Trash and recycling storage must be in the garage except on collection day (normally Mondays) and on the evening before pick up day (normally Sundays). Vegetation cuttings may be placed on the curb only on the day of, or the evening before the pickup day is scheduled. There have been owners fined recently for violations and we want to remind our residents rather than fine them.

2. Please adhere to the speed limit, 19 MPH, stop signs and drive carefully within Westminster. We have had some citations recently and need to insure safety for our residents.

3. There were over 150 citations in the past year for dirty roofs, failure to remulch and landscaping problems. As the rainy season comes to an end, it is time for everyone to review their property's conditions. In a month, the compliance committee will be checking the community and we hope to avoid citations by having the owners spruce up their property.

This message is to inform the owners of things which are problems and an effort to prevent any compliance action.

Pickleball construction will start next week. While reviewing the layout of the courts and basketball hoop it was suggested that since we are preparing to install new tot lot/ playground equipment that we move the basketball hoop to outside the courts onto a paved area 30' by 30' as part of the new play area. The area would have one basketball hoop along with painted lines for kids to play hopscotch and 4 square games. It would also provide a multi use surface for kids to play, bounce balls, ride trikes, etc. This would be the right time to do it while the contractor has the equipment here doing the courts. This new amenity will provide enjoyment for more people than just a hoop on the court. Additionally this new amenity would be part of the playground renovation and costs would come from the community resale fund that is specifically for amenities therefore not impacting HOA fees.

The second bi annual "Swing for Aiden" golf tournament will be held November 14th at the Westminster Golf Course. Aiden Howard is the grandson of residents Tom and LouAnne Dunfee. He has polymicrogyria (PMG), which is a condition characterized by abnormal development of the brain before birth. He requires therapy almost daily. Two years ago the Community raised over \$10,000 to help with expenses. Join us once again this year to help Aiden continue his therapy.
